## **Approach to OCFS**

- Frustration about lack of data sharing,

- Need for upper management of OCFS to communicate with CRP and be appointed as CRP point of contact.
- Desire for involvement and support from PCANY with advocacy

## Communication between CRP, PCA-NY and OCFS:

- Thoughts on voting and communicating through ways other than email and zoom.ex: a place to upload minutes Member only access to a website. Sending out update reports prior to meeting to allow time for more discussion.
- David Suggestion to CAC Doctors/child abuse pediatricians and attorneys to set up a meeting to talk about common hostility being experienced in the family court room setting.

 PCA-NY will continue to hold separate meetings and meet with OCFS to communicate concerns

 PCANY will allocate 1.5-2 hours for future meetings

 PCANY policy staff is engaged with coalition work that overlap with CRP priorities; PCA-NY can keep the Panel informed of information learned, but the policy cannot advocate on behalf of the CRP.
